

MOSAICS

National Tiles has glass, stone and ceramic mosaics available in different shapes and sizes. Mosaics are a great way to add flair and colour. To assist in easy application, all National Tiles mosaics come on 300mm x 300mm sheet with net backing.

How to get the best results!

Pack the walls for an even surface:

If your mosaic tiles are thinner than your floor and wall tiles, you can either pack the wall out or apply more glue.

Match the glue to the glass:

You can use dark or light coloured grout with a glue additive to match your mosaics. For further information please speak to a National Tiles consultant.

Applying adhesive:

Using a 5mm V notch trowel or 6mm trowel. Apply the adhesive horizontally and press tiles firmly into the wall. Use a clean, flat trowel to push the tiles down gently. Ensure that they are flat and level with the existing wall and floor tiles.

REMEMER: Don't push too hard, you don't want the glue to seep through the mosaics. Otherwise you have to remove the mosaic sheet out, clean it and start again.

Avoid cutting individual mosaic tiles.

Instead, work out the featured pattern, measure the distance required and lay the main tile back to the internal corners, to ensure cut tiled are concealed when internal corners are corked.
