Tiling Fact Sheet



No matter how much care you take during the job, sometimes things can go wrong. We have a couple of tips to help you out just in case.

## No Entry Zone:

No matter how often you tell people, someone will accidentally walk on a newly tiled space. Rope it off! Tape it up with **National Tiles fluoro tape** to stop people from standing on the tiles before the glue has set.

## Clean up as you go:

If you see adhesive that is in the wrong spot, get it off quickly. If wet, wipe it up with a cloth. If dry, scrape it up with a spatula, and wipe it with a cloth damp with **National Tiles WAX-OFF**. If the adhesive is dry, scrape it off with a paint scraper and then remove the remaining residue with a damp sponge with **National Tiles WAX-OFF**. Be careful not to damage the tile when you are scraping.



## Replacing a tile:

If everything is completed and you find you have to replace a tile, remove all the grout, smash the tile, chisel it out. Clean out the cavity, add adhesive and insert the new tile. Use the spacers to get it the tile in the right position and then allow to dry. Grout, clean and seal.
